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Severn Suzuki is the daughter of the famous environmental scientist David Suzuki. But the Canadian woman has become an environmentalist on her own.

In 1992, the first U.N. Earth Summit(地球峰会) was held in Rio de Janeiro.

Karachi, Now a City of Trees



Karachi, Pakistan, is one of the hottest cities on Earth. In June 2015, more than 1,000 people d 68 there during a heatwave(持续高温天气). "It was so terrible!" said Shahzad Qureshi, a local citizen. "We need to do something about it!"

After the heatwave, Qureshi took a 69. He set up Urban Forest to plant native trees in Karachi. Trees help cool the air by providing shade and releasing moisture(水分) through their leaves. According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, trees can help lower summer temperatures in cities by 1 to 5°C.

For its f 70 project, Urban Forest planted 1,300 trees in a local park. The group used a special method that helped the trees grow q 71. In just three years, the trees were nine meters tall. Qureshi hopes that one day, the park will become a forest of 50,000 trees.

Qureshi and his t 72 have now helped cool the air in Karachi by planting 12 urban forests in the city. The trees also provide homes for different kinds of animals and food for the citizens. And they create a shady spot for people to relax.

In 2017, Qureshi helped to plant an urban forest at Karachi Grammar School. "The students were e 73 about the project," said Muneza Shaikhali, the school's headteacher. "They themselves have been experiencing the high temperatures during the summer months."

The trees a 74 birds and colorful butterflies. Students go outside during science class to study the forest. "It's like a library of native trees for the kids," says Qureshi. "It's really a wonderful thing to see."
